



DRA2 (English) & EDL (Spanish)– FAQs

END OF THE YEAR – EOY

What data will be entered in Aware?

- **The DRA2 (English) and/or EDL (Spanish)** data will be entered into Aware for each student in K-2.

When is the due date to have all data into Aware?

- The district due date is Friday, May 22.

Who will be entering DRA2 and/or EDL data into Aware?

- The classroom teacher will enter DRA2 and/or EDL data on students into Aware.
- For SPED teachers, the GENED teacher who supervises the reading instruction, and who was trained on the DRA2 this year, is advised to administer and communicate with the SPED teacher. The GENED teacher will enter data into Aware.

Will Grades 3-5 be expected to enter data into Aware?

- **No**, Grades 3-5 are not expected to enter data into Aware
- Grades 3-5 were expected to complete a DRA2 and/or EDL on students below level of 30 and/or Lexile 500

When can teachers begin inputting their data into Aware?

- The student inventory for DRA2 will be open May 20.
- The student inventory will be titled **“DRA2” (English) or “EDL” (Spanish)**.
- Teachers will add the DRA2 **and/or** EDL level along with a few other selections provided in a drop-down manner. Please check to see which inventory you are within prior to entering any data.

Why are we entering DRA2 and/or EDL data district wide into Aware?

- DRA2 / EDL is used as a reading benchmark assessment to monitor growth throughout the school year. Keeping data in Aware will allow tracking of student growth each year.

Will teachers re-administer the Student Reading Survey for EOY?

- No the reading survey does not need to be completed at this time.
- This is a teacher tool used to continue learning about student interest.

Will bilingual students in K-2 need to have the DRA or EDL assessment?

- K & 1st – Middle of Year only EDL (Spanish) - **End of Year both DRA & EDL**
- 2nd – Middle of Year only EDL (Spanish) - **End of Year both DRA & EDL**
